LOCATION

Val di Zoldo is a municipality in the Province of Belluno, in Italy's Veneto Region, located in the heart of the UNESCO Dolomites. Geographically, it sits in the northeastern part of Italy, near the borders with Austria and Slovenia. The surrounding mountains offer opportunities to venture among magnificent rock formations or to explore vast, open landscapes with towering peaks on the horizon—places that evoke a sense of infinity and freedom, inspiring a deep, refreshing breath.

TRANSPORT

The Accredited persons will be served by a shuttle bus service that will run from the hotels to the competition venue according to a scheduled timetable. Details on the shuttle bus timetable will be provided at a later stage, on the GTM.

From 15 to 18 December, shuttle departures to the race venues will be available from each hotel. The first transfer leaves at 7:15 AM, with the exact departure time displayed individually in each hotel.

Shuttles are organized by the OC in cooperation with the hotels. However, as the distances are very short, we recommend using private transport for greater flexibility and independence.

A large parking area is available at Piazza Rodolfo Balestra.

Please note that OC transport will also operate for the Opening Ceremony.

CATERING

Since 15th to 18th December, participants may have lunch at any of the designated partner mountain huts using the meal voucher issued at accreditation. The scheduled lunch period is from 11:45 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

NB. Lunch hours will be extended if competition events run behind schedule.





Parallel Events – Qualification System

The course is set parallel from the beginning and is the same or similar to the parallel final courses. The qualification system consists of two runs, which should be held on the same day whenever possible.

In the first run (Qualification Run), each competitor completes one timed run. Competitors with odd bib numbers (1, 3, 5, ...) start on the red course, and competitors with even bib numbers (2, 4, 6, ...) start on the blue course. The top 16 ranked competitors on each course advance to the Elimination Run. If there is a tie for 16th place, all tied competitors advance. In case of a tie between competitors advancing from the first run, the competitor with the worse seeding position is ranked better.

In the second run (Elimination Run), competitors start in the reverse order of their results from the first run and switch courses (red → blue, blue → red). The final results are based on the total time of the two runs. The top 16 competitors per gender with a valid combined time advance to the final phase. If two or more competitors are tied for a position determining advancement to the final phase (including ties for 4th, 8th, or 16th place), the tie is first broken by the best single run. If still tied, the competitor with the worse seeding position receives the better rank.

For smaller competitor fields (fewer than 32 competitors), the Elimination Run may be conducted with 8 competitors per course (16 in total).

Qualification

Qualification system consists of two runs for each competitor (first male and then female), to establish the ranking for the Finals. In the second run, courses are switched (red → blue, blue → red).

The best times of each male and of each female competitor between the two runs are considered, for each team.

The sum of the best male + female times counts for advancing the teams to Semifinals.

Semifinals

Elimination rounds (match-ups: 1–4, 2–3) are on two runs. In the second run, courses are switched (red → blue, blue → red).

Every victory in parallel race assigns 1 point. The team with more points advances to Final.

In case of tie 2 to 2, the team with the best time in Semifinal (whatever the gender) advances to Final. Further, in case of tie of best time in Semifinal, the team with higher starting list number advances to Final. The looser teams go to Small Final.

Finals

Races for 3rd–4th place and 1st–2nd place. Same system than Semifinals.


This is the European spirit we strive for — a powerful reminder that the idea of a European community grows stronger through sport.

- coaching is **not permitted** in Snow Volleyball;
- sanctions may include a verbal warning, a written warning, or expulsion from the competition site;
- medical Time-Outs follow the FIVB RIT and medical regulations.

Competition Format

Matches shall be played in a best-of-three format. The team that wins two sets shall be declared the winner of the match.

- Each set shall be played to 15 points, with a mandatory 2-point advantage required to win the set.
- A training sign-up sheet will be made available at the Accreditation Office. Each team is required to register for one training slot. Slots will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Each team is entitled to 7 minutes of on-court warm-up prior to the start of its match.

The subsequent match will commence 10 minutes after the conclusion of the previous match.

- Matches listed with a “not before” time (e.g., 14:40) shall not begin earlier than the indicated time. Matches may, however, begin at or after that time in the event of delays.

Player's shirts

Each team must have one set of four shirts, numbered 1 to 4, with numbers displayed on both the chest and the back. The Organising Committee will provide all teams with a set of official shirts, which will be delivered in Sala Fusine at the Accreditation Office. All players on a team must wear uniforms of the same colour and style in accordance with tournament regulations.
